"Super"

Includes:

- More than 1 Season of Interest and Characteristic
 Appeal
- Multiple Forms, Habits, Textures
- Hardiness (Soil, Water, Drought, Exposure)
- Colorful (Bloom, Bark, Fruit, Foliage)



Arctostaphylos – Manzaneta

- I.D. Evergreen, Leaves Leathery, Creeping to Mounding
- Super Shrub
 - Broadleaf Evergreen
 - Urn-shaped Flowers Late Winter
 - Red Berries
 - Native
 - Stem Color



- Berberis Barberry
- I.D. Thorns, Simple Leaves Without Spines
- Super Shrub
 - Yellow Spring Flowers
 - Red Summer Berries Persistent
 - Leaf Color
 - Forms & Sizes



- Buddleia species Butterfly Bush
- I.D. Opposite & One Alternate
- Super Shrub
 - Large Showy Flowers, Many Colors
 - Everblooming Summer-Fall till Freeze
 - Bees & Butterfly
 - Forms and Sizes



- Cornus Species Dogwood
- I.D. Opposite, Leaves w/ Pinnate Veins
- Super Shrub
 - Late Spring Flowers
 - Pearly Summer Berries
 - Leaf Color: Variegation, Autumn
 - Winter Stem Color



- Euonymus alatus Burning Bush
- I.D. Corky Winged Stems
- Super Shurb
 - Fall Color
 - Small Yellow Flowers
 - Reddish Orange Fruit, Persistent through Winter
 - Winter Texture



- Euonymus x fortunei Wintercreeper
- I.D. Opposite, Serrated Leaves
- Super Shrub
 - Broadleaf Evergreen
 - Habit Shrubby, Vining, Groundcover
 - Winter Color



- Euonymus kiautschovica Manhattan Euonymus
- I.D. Opposite, Rounded Leaves
- Super Shrub
 - Broadleaf Evergreen
 - Semi-Shade
 - Fruit Colorful, Persistent



- Hibiscus species Rose of Sharon, Althea
- I.D. Opposite, Leaves Lobed, Persistent Seed Capsules
- Super Shrub
 - Flowers Large, Showy, Single or Double
 - Forms & Sizes
 - Many Flower Colors
 - Late Season Bloom



- Hydrangea species Hydrangea
- I.D. Opposite, Flowers w/ Showy Bracts
- Super Shrub
 - Large Showy Summer Flowers
 - Forms & Sizes
 - Flower Color PH Dependant



- Juniperus species Juniper
- I.D. Leaf Type, Habit
- Super Shrub
 - Evergreen
 - Forms and Sizes
 - Various Colors



- Mahonia aquifolium Oregon-grape Holly
- I.D. Glossy, Pinnately Compound, Spiny Leaves
- Super Shrub
 - Yellow Spring Flowers
 - Blue Summer Berries
 - Broadleaf Evergreen



- Perovskia atriplicifolia Russian Sage
- I.D. Pinnate Lobed Leaves, Suckering Habit
- Super Shrub
 - Drought Tolerance (Water Use)
 - Foliage Color
 - Late Season Color
 - Pollinators



- Physocarpus opulifolius Ninebark
- I.D. Alternate, Lobed Leaves, Bark
- Super Shrub
 - Exfoliating Bark Winter Interest
 - Later Spring Clusters of Flowers
 - Sizes & Colors



- Potentilla fruticosa Shrubby Cinquefoil / Potentilla
- I.D. Lobed Leaves, 5-Petaled Flowers
- Super Shrub
 - Everblooming
 - Flower Colors
 - Habit: Low to Mounding



- Rhus species- Sumac
- I.D. Alternate, Lobed to Pinnate, Suckering, Flower/Seed Clusters
- Super Shrub
 - Fall Color
 - Drought/Alkaline Tolerance
 - Form & Texture



- Ribes species Currant
- I.D. Lobed Leaves
- Super Shrub
 - Spring Flowers: Showy or Inconspicuous
 - Summer Berries, Some Edible
 - Fall Color
 - Form



- Rosa Rose
- I.D. Alternate, Pinnate Leaves, Thorns
- Super Shrub
 - Sizes & Habits
 - Colors
 - Flower Types & Times



- Syringa Lilac
- I.D. Opposite, Glossy Leathery Leaves
- Super Shrub
 - Showy Spring Flowers
 - Fragrance
 - Succession of Bloom Times
 - Forms



- Viburnum species Viburnum
- I.D. Opposite, Leathery Leaves, Flower Buds
- Super Shrub
 - Spring Flowers
 - Summer Berries
 - Fall Color
 - Forms and Sizes
