### General graded examinations

Candidate must be 7 years or over. There is no upper age limit. Candidates should enter in pairs. Where there are an odd number of candidates, the extra candidate should be entered with a pair, making a group of three.

### Vocational graded examinations

Intermediate Foundation & Intermediate should be scheduled at the start of an examining day.

Advanced 1 and Advanced 2 candidates are only examined at Centres unless the whole day consists of Vocational Graded Examinations. Candidates should be entered in pairs. Where there are an odd number of candidates at Intermediate Foundation and Intermediate levels, a group of three may be entered. Where there are an odd number of candidates for Advanced 1 and Advanced 2, the candidate should be entered separately.

Male and Female candidates are not to be entered together.

### Professional examinations

Candidates are examined singly

DDE UNIT 4	2 hours
LICENTIATE	2 ½ hours
FELLOWSHIP	2 ¾ hours

### ▪ Class examinations

- Teachers are expected to present the work to the children in the examination room.
- The order of the syllabus should be reasonably adhered to.
- Every child must have his/her number pinned to dress or leotard.
- Teachers must fill in the candidates' **names** as well as their **numbers** on the **rough report forms**. This should be done in the order that the children will stand across the room, regardless of the line. Each form has spaces for maximum 5 children and one form should be used for each group. Supplies of these forms can be obtained from HQ.
- The forms should be handed to the examiner on her arrival

### ▪ Pre-Primary

- The minimum number of candidates is 3, maximum of 5.
- The timings are as follows:

Candidates	Timings
3 or 4	20 minutes (15 minutes dancing plus 5 minutes writing time)
5	25 minutes (20 minutes dancing plus 5 minutes writing time)

### ▪ Primary, Standards 1,2 & 3

- The time allowed for each examination is 30 minutes (25 minutes examination plus 5 minutes writing time)
- The minimum number of candidates is **three**
- **The ideal number of candidates is four**
- If there are more than four candidates the recommendations are as follows:

6	Two groups of 3
7	One group of 4 and one of 3
8	Two groups of 4
9	One group of 4 and one group of 5
10	One group of 4 and two groups of 3
11	Two groups of 4 and one group of 3
12	Three groups of 4

- The **minimum age** of entry for **Primary** is **5 years**.
- The teacher will adapt the work for boys

### ▪ Standards 4,5 & 6

- The time allowed for each examination is 45 minutes (40 minutes examination plus 5 minutes writing time)
- Under no circumstances should mature candidates be entered with teenagers
- At these levels the ideal number of candidates is four, but fewer will be accepted if there are not these numbers in the whole session

### • Senior Certificate 1 & 2

- The time allowance is 45 minutes for one candidate and 60 minutes for two or three candidates
- No teacher is allowed to enter the examination room
- Female candidates are welcome to wear a short skirt (optional)
- The maximum number of candidates to enter in one set is three
