Eligible Entrants:

Any restaurant, bar, eatery or snack shop located in Estes Park or Grand Lake that is willing to meet the requirements of the competition as described below.

Entry Categories:

There are 5 spots available in each category for each destination (30 entries total). Up to 15 businesses will be included from each community; spots will be filled on a first-come basis with the goal of including 30 different businesses total, if possible. If space allows, restaurants may enter into more than one category. Please rank your desired categories on the entry form below. Note: second or third entries will be allowed after all participating businesses have received a first category.

- Drink or Cocktail
- Snack or Dessert

How it will work:

Guests to Estes Park and Grand Lake will be able to print off or pick up an entry form from participating locations or each community's visitor center. Votes can also be cast via social media by posting a picture of an entry dish/drink with the entry's assigned hashtag (ex. #CentennialCookoff31). The paper ballots and supporting webpages will have a name, description and location information for each entry. If a guest tries every dish on the ballot and collects initials and secret code from their server at each establishment, they can enter their ballot for the chance to win a prize package including a \$100 gift certificate from a winning restaurant and a nationwide annual national parks pass!

Voting will be conducted from May 22nd, 2015 (Memorial Day Weekend Friday) to September 4th, 2015 (RMNP Centennial). A kick-off event will be held in Estes Park over Memorial Day Weekend. Winners will be announced over Labor Day Weekend, and an awards ceremony will be held as part of Constitution Days in Grand Lake on September 19th. Guests will have the opportunity to sample the winning dishes through the month of September.

The competition will be marketed by both Visit Estes Park and the Grand Lake Chamber online, in paid and organic promotion, as well as with the regional press at an invitation-only, centennial- themed press event and through general press relations, pitching, press releases, etc. We will also invite the media to attend the kick-off and award events that will book-end the competition.
