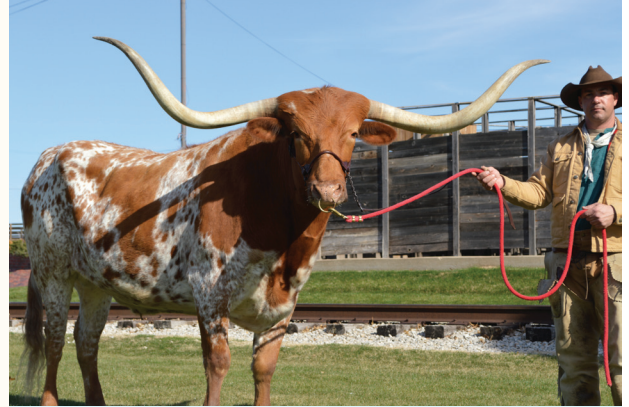




THE FORT WORTH HERD
