FREE THINGS TO DO in Greater Fort Lauderdale

8 beaches, so many ways to play

Enjoy a day of fun in the sun at eight distinct beaches in Greater Fort Lauderdale, spanning 23 miles of Blue Wave certified beaches.



Meditate as you watch the sunrise on beautiful Deerfield Beach, Broward County's cove-like beach with fishing pier, volleyball and surf lessons. Hillsboro Beach boasts the brightest lighthouse on the East Coast with monthly tours through the Hillsboro Lighthouse Preservation Society. Heading south, enjoy Pompano Beach, a favorite spot for families with playgrounds, fishing pier, dive shops and boat charters. Catch the Old Florida "beach village" vibe of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea's half-mile hamlet and snorkel (no boat needed) from shore along three-tiered reefs. Stroll, jog, or bike along the Fort Lauderdale beachfront promenade, a charming cosmospolitan spot. Dania Beach is home to some of the least-crowded streches of shoreline, and a favorite for kayaking, swimming and picnicking. Hollywood is retro-cool and laid back with a 2 1/2-mile Broadwalk that is ideal for walking, cycling (try a fun-cycle), and jogging. Hallandale Beach is a great spot for watersports along a beautiful stretch of beach.

natural wonders: parks and nature centers

Greater Fort Lauderdale is a gateway to the Everglades and more. Enjoy some of mother earth's most amazing wonders. A sampling (more at sunny.org/nature):



Climb (or elevator) to the observation tower, or follow the boardwalk at Anne Kolb Nature Center at West Lake Park in Hollywood, a mangrove estuary and habitat for wading birds and other native wildlife. Central Broward Regional Park, in Lauderhill, is the only certified US Cricket stadium, free on weekdays, with soccer/football fields, netball, tennis, basketball and water playground. Fern Forest Nature Center, in Coconut Creek, offers a serene setting with picnic shelter, amphitheater, and Royal Fern Hall. Snake Warrior's Island, Miramar, is a 53.3-acre nature preserve along the Great Florida Birding Trail. Stroll downtown Fort Lauderdale's Riverwalk along the New River to attractions, restaurants and shops. Talk through the "whispering dishes," or tell time with the gravity clock at the Museum of Discovery & Science.
