TURTLE SEASON IS HERE

Sea turtle nesting season began March 1. These large marine reptiles will soon begin visiting our beaches at night with regularity. Females of three different species of sea turtle come ashore at night, lay their eggs and return to the sea. Loggerhead turtles may lay four to five nests per turtle per season, with each nest containing an average of 110 eggs. The peak of the nesting season in Broward County is June and July. If you are on the beach at night and see a large turtle coming ashore, please observe this phenomenon from a distance.
