Staffing Guidelines

- RN present at all times
- MICT approved as a secondary provider
- State of Hawaii licensure to practice as RN or MICT
- Minimum training: BCLS / ACLS
- Minimum level of care: Basic Life Support

Staff requirement - Minimum

Number of Conventioneers

0 - 5,000 1 RN 5,001 - 10,000 1 RN and 1 MICT 10,001 - 15,000 2 RNs 15,001 - 25,000 2 RNs and 1 MICT 25,001+ 3 RNs

Special Consideration

• Events in which alcohol will be served may require additional staff depending on number of participants, and will be negotiated at time of contract

Hours of service determined by needs of client

Services Provided

- First Aid Room staffed at HCC
- Staff will answer emergency calls anywhere in HCC
- First Aid services include: Emergency Life Support measures including defibrillation, CPR and Airway Management
- Simple wound care
- Limited over-the-counter medication

- Referrals to Straub Clinic & Hospital (or other facility as appropriate) and Straub Doctors
 On Call 24-hour clinic in Waikiki
- Simple non-chargeable first aid supplies
- Safe & private medical room for treatment or holding until appropriate transport arrives (i.e. ambulance, Doctors on Call van, taxi)

Additional Services

- Assist with ambulance standby arrangements
- Medical Equipment Referral list

- MICTs \$25.00 per hour
- Interpreter (Translator) \$15.00 per hour
- No overtime/holiday premium charge
