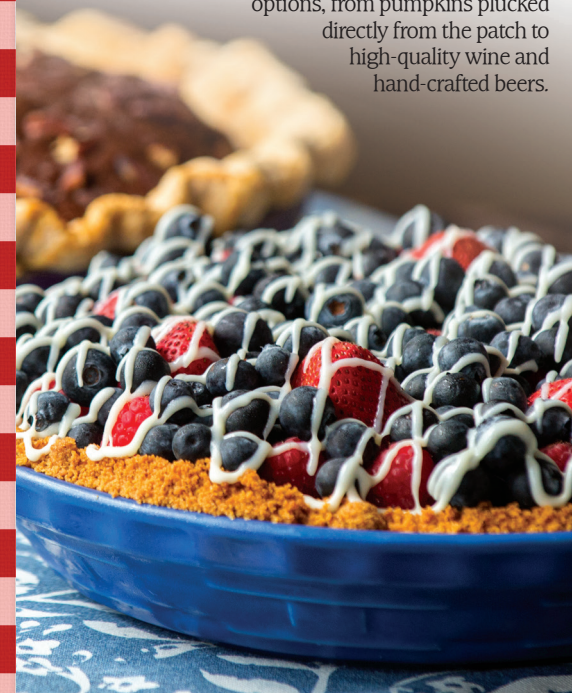

Gather your group and head just a few minutes west of Indianapolis to Hendricks County, Indiana, to enjoy an authentic taste of the state's food culture.



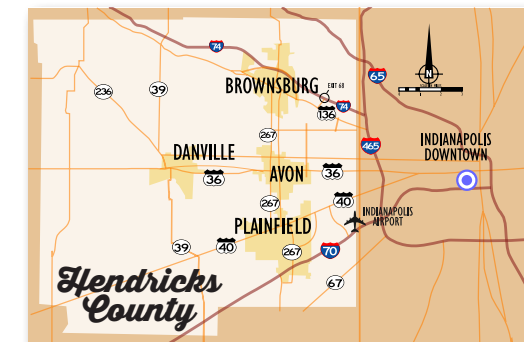
