The best way to learn about history is when you can see it and touch it. This area is fortunate to have a rich history from important eras of American history, like the Lewis and Clark Expedition of the early 1800s (and the Native Americans who came before them), the Civil War years of the mid-1800s and immigration of the early 1900s. Intertwined with that history are memorials to several wars and unique sites and museums you may not know exist.

## Get To Know Us

If you really want to get to know the area, get a sense of its foundation and learn a little along the way, Kansas City, KS, has several museums that aim to educate and enlighten. A good place to start is the **Wyandotte County Museum**. The oldest artifacts there belong to the Trowbridge collection, originating from the Hopewell culture, over 3,000 years ago. The museum also has a vast collection of Native American artifacts and county items from individuals, businesses and organizations. Have you ever heard of Moses Grinter? He established the first ferry across the Kansas River, and his family's beautiful farmstead home overlooking the Kansas River is now the **Grinter Place State Historic Site**. **Strawberry Hill Museum and Cultural Center** promotes, sponsors and preserves the ethnic heritage prevalent in Kansas City, KS.

## History At Your Fingertips

To learn more about slavery, abolitionist John Brown and the Underground Railroad, all you have to do is visit the Quindaro area of Kansas City, KS. At the **Old Quindaro Museum**, take a tour of the home and ruins (available upon request). You can also gain a unique perspective from this period of U.S. history by visiting the **Quindaro Underground Railroad Museum** and **Quindaro Ruins Overlook**. The town of Quindaro, in what is now Kansas City, KS, was founded in 1856 as a port of entry for free soil immigrants into Kansas. It also became an important station on the Underground Railroad.

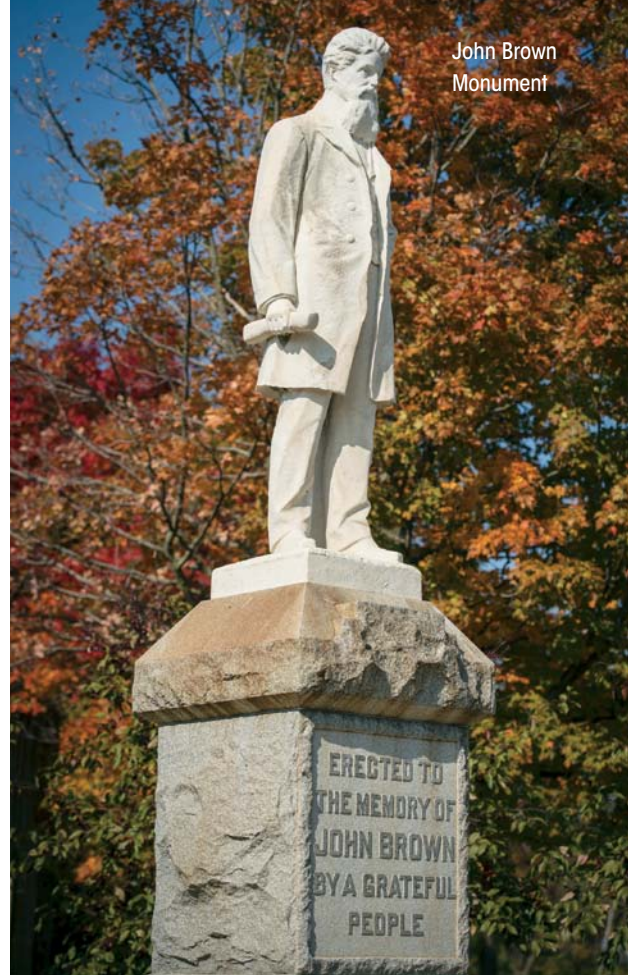

## War Memorials

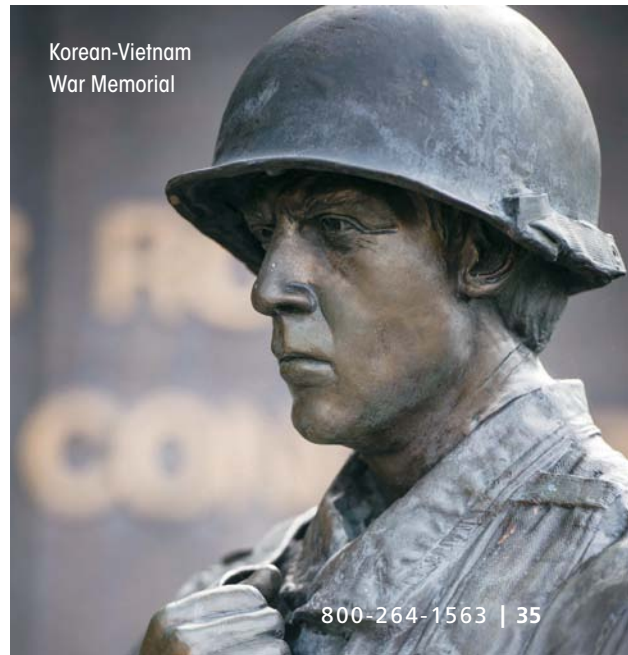
The people who have served this country and protected it during wars are recognized in several spots around Kansas City, KS. The marble **Korean-Vietnam War Memorial**, with two life-size bronze statues, was formally dedicated on Veterans Day 1988. The **Rosedale Memorial Arch** is dedicated to the citizens of Rosedale who served in World War I. The **World War II Bomber Builders Monument**, located on the grounds of the Wyandotte County Historical Society and Museum, honors the 56,337 men and women who built more than 6,000 B-25 Mitchell Medium bombers in Kansas City, KS, during World War II.

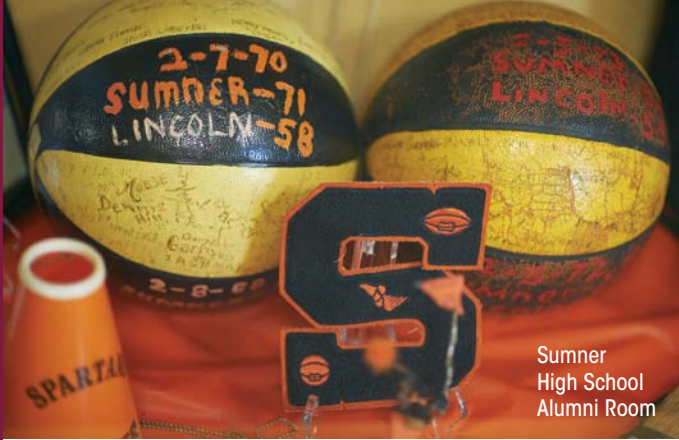

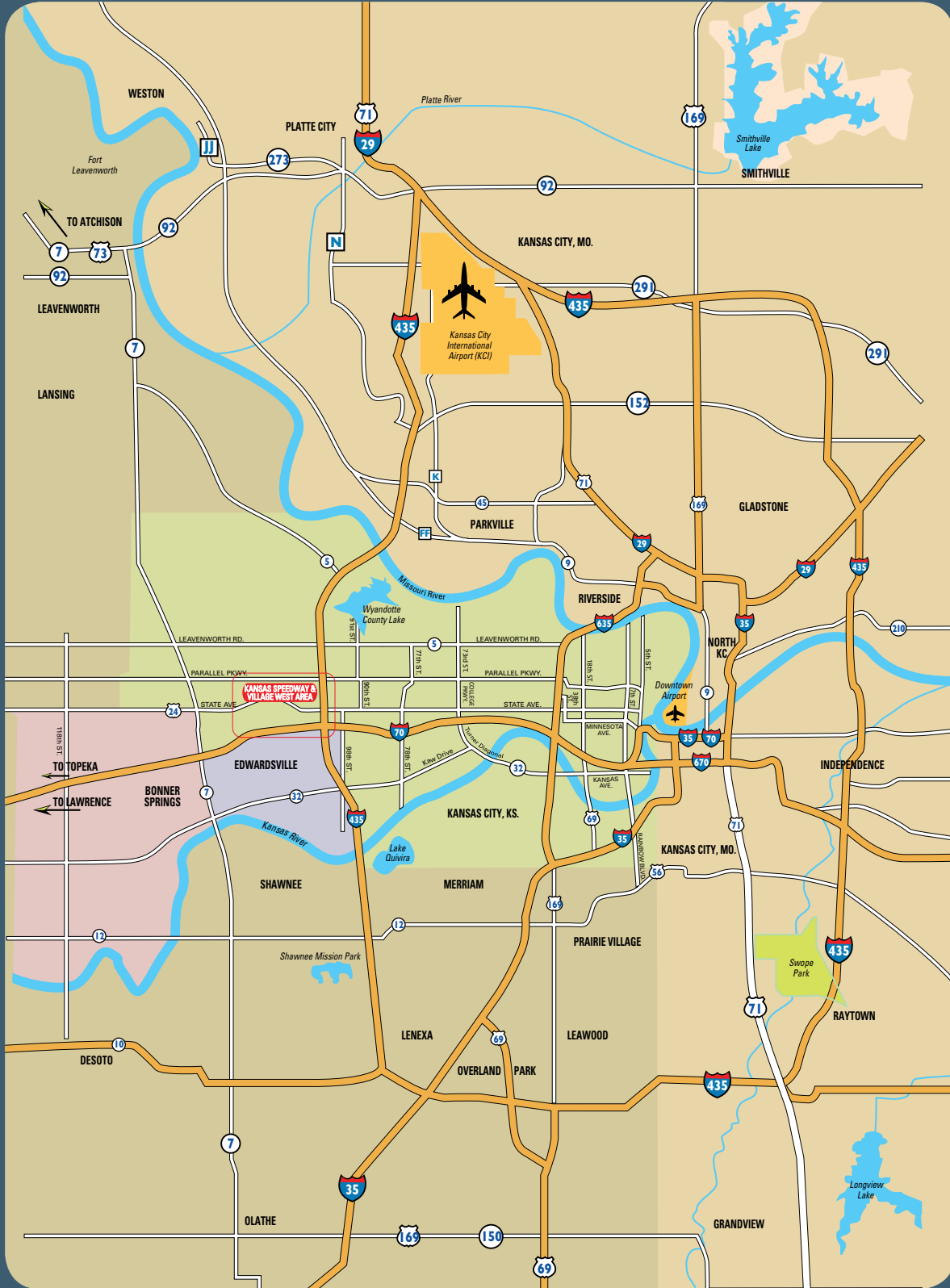

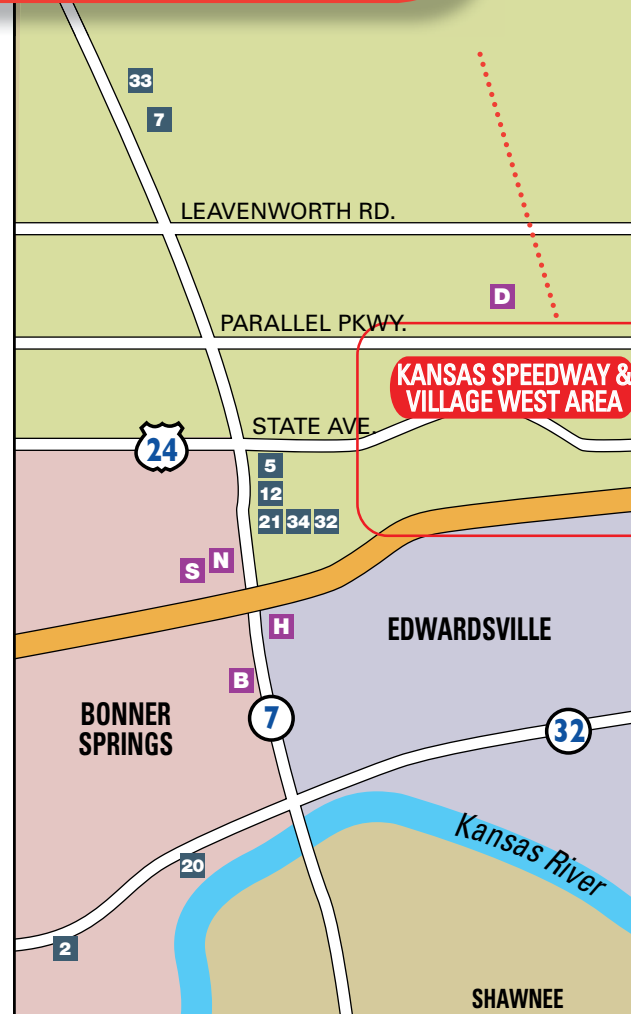
