## Historic Fincastle includes Museum, walking tour

The Historical Museum of Botetourt County is housed in Historic Fincastle and features over 800 artifacts reflecting the County’s rich history. The museum is open 7 days a week and welcomes both individuals and groups. The Museum is also part of the Historic Fincastle Walking Tour. Combining the talents of German craftsmen and Scots-Irish merchants and lawyers, early Fincastle residents built a town of well-proportioned houses and public buildings, a substantial number of which still survive. Court House Square contains the Jeffersonian-style courthouse, a jail and the old Western Hotel. Three antebellum and two late 19<sup>th</sup> century churches still serve their congregations. The narrow streets are lined with a variety of architectural styles. Houses of early smiths, wagon makers and saddlers were usually built of logs and covered with clapboards. Commercial establishments and houses of the more wealthy were built of brick. The surrounding countryside is also rich in frontier architecture and historic lore.



## Heritage Family Market

Heritage Family Market opened in December 2013 and now, the 4,000-square foot space is half retail — a deli counter, dairy and frozen food sections, and shelves of dry and canned goods — and half warehouse, office space and food prep/bakery. Heritage Family Market sells deli sliced meats & cheeses, and has a bakery with fresh bread, cinnamon and raspberry rolls and whoopie pies. They sell bulk foods like flour, sugar, spices, soup mix, cappuccino mix, hot cocoa mix and nuts packaged for purchase. Frozen fruits and vegetables as well as dried fruits are also available for purchase. The store also sells jar goods like salsa, chow chow, pickles, relish, jams and jellies. Much of the store’s inventory comes from Amish and Mennonite suppliers in Ohio and Pennsylvania, but several Virginia-produced items are on the store’s shelves as well. Eggs are free-range and farm fresh from within Botetourt County; cornmeal is procured from Big Spring Mill in Elliston, Virginia.



### Harris Hall of Antiques
